All Supplies unless stated from Stampin' Up! – Available to buy from me either in person or online:

<u>Stamp Sets:-</u> Everything Eleanor (124164), I Love Lace (134033) and Stippled Blossoms (126747)

Inks: To coordinate with chosen Cardstock & Ribbon Colours

Cardstock: Very Vanilla A4 (106550) & 1 feature colour

and 1 coordinating Colour, Speciality Typeset DSP, scrap backing board from DSP paper stacks

Ribbon - Seam Binding, Grosgrain & Chevron in coordinating colours

Embellishments: Rhinestones Basic Jewels (119246

Tools: - Stampin' Trimmer (129722), Bone Folder (102300) Paper Snips (103579)



<u>Adhesives:</u> Sticky Strip (104294), Tombow Liquid Glue (110755)

To buy from Poundland – calculator, calendar blanks (10 for £1) and pen (10 for £1) – note book from Stampin up


Steps

- 1. From the scrap backing board cut the base layer 6 ¼ inches x 9 ½ inches
- 2. Using the Speciality Typeset paper cut a piece 11 ½ inches x 8 ¼ inches, score at 1 inch on all four sides, trim corners and cover scrap backing board, folding over excess underneath.
- 3. Using your main colour (same colour as the grosgrain ribbon) cut a piece 9 ½ inches x 8 ¼ inches. Score on the shorter side at 1 inch and 2 inches. Adhere first 1inch

(scored) of cover to the base of the typeset covered board. Cover underside of board to enclose the front flap with a piece of Sahara sand or neutral card stock cut to $6 \% \times 9 \%$

- 4. Adhere calculator with sticky strip.
- 5. Cut a small piece of chevron ribbon and adhere with sticky strip. Cover pen with a small piece of Typeset DSP (5 inches x 2 inches). Tie in place

6. Using coordinating card stock make pocket for note book – stamp a piece of card 6 ¼ inches x 4 ½ inches with I love Lace and coordinating ink. Score at 1 inch and 1 ¼ inches on sides and bottom, trim corners as shown and adhere pocket using sticky strip



- Decorate calendar blank with ribbon and adhere to the front of the pocket
- 8. Embellish notebook with stamping using I Love Lace as a base to cover notebook, with swirls from Everything Eleanor and Stippled Blossom Flowers (or decorate as desired)
- 9. Decorate top of flap as

shown with ribbon and adhere to top flap.
